Section C – Child and Family Services

Filter Criteria that will affect this entire section:

Children: Children that were enrolled at any time during the enrollment year begin and end dates will be counted only once towards any question on the PIR. Additionally, they will only be included if their funding matches a funding picked on the **PIR Setup Tab**. You can update the funding for a child by editing the **Enrollment** details in the **Enrollment** module for the child, or by using the **Enrollment Utility** to modify the funding for multiple children.

Pregnant Women: Pregnant women will be included in the PIR if they meet the same criteria for children and they have a pregnancy record. Questions that state *Children Only* will exclude pregnant women from the count.

Families: Families will be included only once on the PIR if they have at least one child enrolled under a funding selected on the **PIR Setup Tab**. Children in dual-custody situations will have both families show up on the PIR.

ChildPlus counts PIR questions related to family once for every program term record. If a family has two children enrolled in the same program, ChildPlus will compare their data for *Yes/No questions* and use the following formula to determine how the family counts on the PIR:

- If both children have a *No* for this question, then the family will be counted as *No* on the PIR.
- If both children have a Yes for this question, then the family will be counted as Yes on the PIR.
- If one child has a No for this question and the other child has a Yes, then the family will be counted as Yes on the PIR.

If the family has two or more children that will count on different PIRs, ChildPlus will count whatever value exists in *each* child's record. For example, say a family has two children (one in HS and one in EHS). The EHS child has a *Yes* for the Homeless question and the HS has a *No.* In this case, the family will count *Yes* for **C.43** on the EHS PIR and *No* on the HS PIR.
